 - Have current identification showing your age
 - Be willing and able to provide loving attention, medical care and life-time stability for a dog.
 - Understand that Pal's Place Rescue reserves the right to deny any adoption application.
 - Please answer all questions. Applications with blank questions will not be processed.
- Please remember that we receive many applications every day, often for the same dog. Please be as specific as possible when answering these questions so that we can accurately understand what animal will be the best fit for your family. If multiple applications are received for one dog, we will review them in order to determine which home might be the best fit for that particular dog.
